Service Pack 2 Change Log December 6, 2007

Shares features with Legal Library 2007

Faster start-up time – check for updates occurs at shut-down time, not start-up time.

Separate export buttons for Locked and Draft client review documents.

Client review documents are standard Word Documents, clients no longer need Legal Library Document Editor to review them.

Revision History can be reviewed.

Revisions are less obtrusive when printed for more professional looking documents.

Not possible to open multiple saved documents at once.

Better support for Non-Admin Users

Various problems have been reported for Non-Admin users. These should all be resolved in this version. Issues included

- importing license file
- updating forms.
- other scattered problems

To correct these problems, certain support files such as license keys have been relocated. (See ‘Support Files Location’ below for details).

New Features

Editing

- Previously documents could not be edited after they were opened until an editing mode was selected. Forms now always open in ‘Fill-in-Form’ mode. Also, to avoid certain errors, forms are always forced out of ‘Edit-Text’ mode before closing.
- Previously the ‘Document Fields’ pop-up form opened every time ‘Fill-in-Form’ mode was entered, whether it was wanted or not. Now a separate toolbar button is provided for use when it is needed.

Eliminated Extraneous 'Save File?' Prompts

- Previously users would always be asked if they wanted to save a file, even if it had just been saved. This is now corrected.

Default Save Directory

- Previously the system would ask to set the Default Save Directory value on every save, or it could be shut off, taking away the ability to change the value. Now there is a separate File menu item for setting this value whenever desired.

Document file handling

- Double-clicking on a Legal Library document (.cbd) would bring up a password prompt. Now a message explaining to open the file using the Legal Library file menu or toolbar is presented to the user.

Export for Client Review

- When exporting a document for client review you will be prompted whether you want to create a locked document (final copy) or an unlocked document (draft copy). Clients can edit draft copies by using the Legal Library Client Document Editor. Draft copies only will have a 'Draft' watermark added to them.

Toolbar Changes

Auto-Line Numbering

- A toolbar button to easily toggle Auto-Line numbering on/off has been added.

Keep Paragraphs Together

- The toolbar button for this feature has been dropped. This functionality is available for the current paragraph in your document via the Word main menu: Select Format/Paragraph/Line and Page Breaks/Keep Lines Together

Document Compare

- Previously Word's built-in functionality was used to merge a previously exported document with the original version. However, it was shown that at times some data was lost. As a result 'Document Compare' in the new version simply opens the two documents side-by-side for visual comparison. You will need to manually merge any changes. If the functionality of automated merging in Word is corrected, we will-renable this feature.

Installer and Licensing

Installer

- Explicitly checks for Administrator privileges prior to running.
- Explicitly checks for .Net 2.0 runtime.
- Explicitly checks for Word 2002 / 2003 installation.

Install Code creation and verification

- fixed bug which created incomplete install codes
- no longer uses WMI (Windows Instrumentation) which was problematic in some cases; Uses Volume Serial Number instead.
- Works with install codes from created in previous version or this version

License Verification and Registration

- No longer reports that 'License Expired' immediately after installation
- Provides helpful Registration form until license is installed
- Does not require any license (even a Trial license) for installation

Auto Update

Auto Update feature

- now a separate executable for better performance.
- Cancel button added
- Now a two-part update to allow updating of program files in use
- Prompts for Admin / Power User credentials if needed

Diagnostics

On-site Diagnostics

- User configurable trace files can now be generated. These are written to the desktop.

Miscellaneous

Internal restructuring to make code more robust – not visible to user.

Windows Vista

Running Legal Library under Windows Vista is supported.

Support Files Location

Previous location: C:\Program Files directory tree to the appropriate directory in

New Location in Windows XP: C:\Documents And Settings\All Users\Application Data

New Location in Windows Vista: C:\ProgramData

In normal usage you need not be aware of these details.

For users upgrading from version 4.0:

Differences in Legal Library 2005 compared to Legal Library v.4

- 1) Legal Library 2005 can be used while MS Word and Outlook are running.
- 2) Ability to Fill in fields from a pop-up data entry form.
- 3) Email documents from within Legal Library 2005.
- 4) Clients can review and modify draft copies sent to them.
- 5) Save existing file with a new name.
- 6) Automatic document and program updates
